NOTES FROM THE LIBRARY is an attempt to keep readers better informed about this service of the Institute. It will appear every two months with the RECENT ACQUISITIONS list.

Everyone who has been frustrated by the piles of unshelved books will welcome the additional space now available in the Commons Room for part of the non-scientific book collection. Several hundred volumes, most of which were purchased before 1958, have been placed on these shelves. For those wanting a book from the topmost shelf - patience! A satisfactory and, we hope, safe method of ascent is being planned. For the present, those borrowing books from the Commons Room are asked to deposit the blue charge card in the withdrawal box in the main Library.

The Library is now getting many books on approval. Approximately twice a month these are placed on a table in the Reading Room for inspection. Each book contains a card which readers are asked to sign if they feel the book should be purchased. Many valuable titles have thus been added to the collection by this method. However, your suggestions of titles, either for purchase or for inspection, are still important if our collection is to serve the needs of all of those who use the Library.
