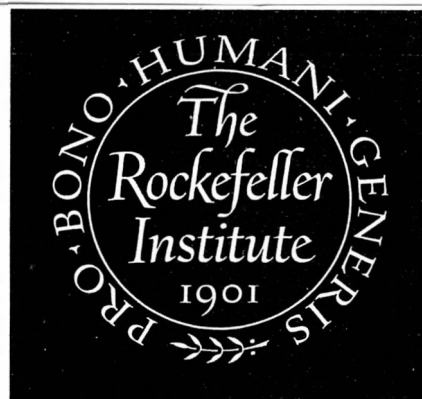

NOTES FROM THE LIBRARY



The first book bearing the imprint of The Rockefeller Institute Press appeared in December. This volume, published in association with Oxford University Press, is "The Atmosphere and the Sea in Motion; Scientific Contributions to the Rossby Memorial Volume," edited by Bert Bolin.

Carl-Gustav Rossby was a distinguished Swedish-American whose contributions to the science of meteorology have been memorialized in this volume of scientific papers by his former students and colleagues.

Books published by The Rockefeller Institute Press may be purchased through the Library at a 40% discount.

In press: "The Ethical Dilemma of Science; Selected Papers and Addresses," by Professor A. V. Hill.

The classification of the books in the Library is progressing much faster than was anticipated. It is hoped that this program will be completed before the end of this year, so that the entire book collection can be arranged by subject according to the Library of Congress classification system.

On December 31, 1959 there were 13,991 books in the Library of which approximately 68% have been classified. The 4,606 volumes yet to be done are books which were in the Library before April 1, 1958, the date on which the classification program began.

The considerable amount of work involved in such a project may not be generally understood. It has necessitated the re-typing of all catalogue cards of all books in the Library at the start of this program. Many of these books also

had to be re-catalogued. In 21 months 29,514 cards have been typed. If they were piled in a single column it would be 25 feet high.
