Dear Dr. Flexner,

In accordance with our conversation to-day we are arranging to employ additional help to permit the opening of the library evenings from 6 to 10, Saturdays from 1 to 5, and on Sundays and Holidays from 10 a. m. to 5 p. m. We have in view a mature woman who has had library training and who seems to be of suitable calibre, ~~who can take over part of this schedule at the rate of~~ 50 cents per hour. The total monthly payment to her would be \$36 per month. The remaining evenings, five in number, would be taken over by a young man, perhaps Dr. Gates' previous technician, Meyer, at a rate of about 40 cents an hour, involving a total of about \$30 per month. The total commitment would then be \$66 per month and would require an appropriation from the contingent fund of \$250.
